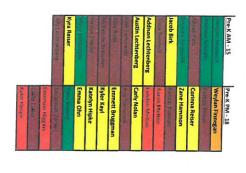


## Superintendent Report September 12, 2016

During discussion of the amended budget Mr. Lechtenberg explained his concerns that \$ .0085 levy results in a near breakeven in real expenditures for the year and depending on the percent of Budget spent could result in a slight increase or decrease in district cash reserves.
